



DRESS FOR SUCCESS

Interviews are a time to put your best foot forward. Interviewees are expected to be polished and dressed for success within their field. It is recommended to choose neutral pieces to keep attention on your responses rather than attire. This is your time to let your answers shine!

Recommended Checklist:

- Cell phone on silent and make sure vibrate is turned off
- Clean shaven/ clean face/ neatly trimmed beard
- Hair should be neat, clean and combed away from your face
- Teeth and breath are fresh and clean – DO NOT chew gum during your interview
- Facial piercings should be removed, small earrings are appropriate
- Tattoos should be covered in an interview setting
- Jewelry, makeup, perfume or cologne should be kept to a minimum
- Hands are clean, nails are trimmed and cracked or peeling nail polish is removed
- Pants should be at your waist with a belt
- Skirts and dresses should be no more than 1" above the knee
- Shoes are clean,

Things to Avoid:

- No shorts, legging
- No t-shirts, hood
- No sneakers, sandals
